The Middle Tennessee School of Anesthesia's new \$1.2 million major teaching theatre classroom addition was officially opened at noon, March 23, 2006 following a festive ribbon cutting ceremony. Community friends and leaders, students, faculty, staff and alumni attended the event. There was a lovely reception including refreshments and a tour following the ceremony.

Construction and additional renovations continue at the school as part of an overall master plan building project. The renovations include expansion of its physical plant which includes more than doubling the size of its current classroom, library, computer lab, operating room/simulation lab, student lounge, study areas, and student services space. "After operating under very challenging space restrictions for many years, we are very blessed to have this wonderful opportunity to better serve our students," said President Hunt. "MTSA has grown enormously these last two to three years. It's not been growth for growth sake—we are simply responding to a massive market driven demand to provide quality Christian anesthesia education in the region," continued Hunt. "If MTSA did not respond—other universities in the area were ready to step up and do it. As the second largest Certified Registered Nurse Anesthesia school in the country, I'm pleased MTSA continues to be a leader in anesthesia education—producing unparalleled graduates with the leadership and skills to provide excellent service.

What do you think of the new library?

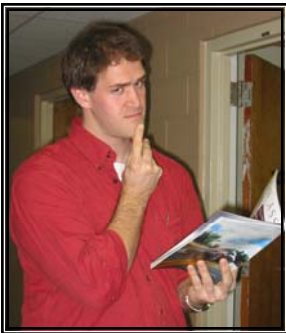
Having the resources more available is very nice.

Sunday, April 30, 2006 Continuing Education Credits Workshop

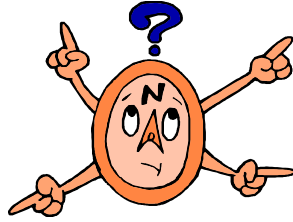
Come See the New MTSA Classroom!!!!

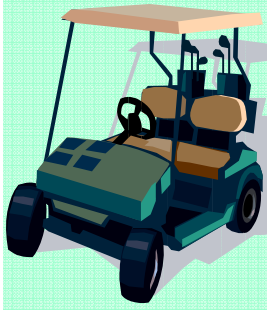

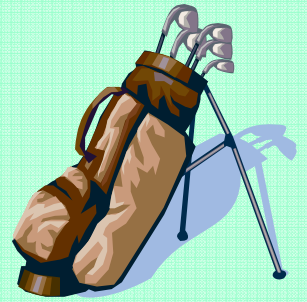

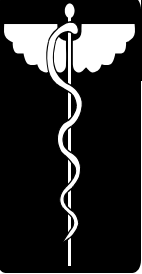
